



# Your **INTERACTIVE** Passport Through

- 1** In the nursery rhyme “I’m a little teapot”, what is the 15th word?
- My (turn right)
  - Handle (turn left)
  - Spout (turn left)
  - Short (turn right)

- 2** Recite “Twinkle Twinkle Little Star”, pointing opposite directions for each word. Go whichever direction you are pointing on the 16th word.

HINT: Start by pointing to the right

- 3** In the game, Rock-Paper-Scissors, what do scissors lose to? If you can’t remember, play the game together.
- Rock (turn left)
  - Paper (turn right)

- 4** In the nursery rhyme “Little Miss Muffet”, what sat down beside her and scared her away?
- Snake (turn left)
  - Spider (turn right)
  - Bee (turn left)
  - Ghost (turn right)

- 5** On which side of your body is your heart located?
- left (turn right)
  - right (turn left)

**What is the 4th command in the Hokey Pokey?**

- You turn around (turn right)
- Take your right hand out (turn left)
- You shake it all about (turn left)

**What was the 3rd piggy's action in the song "This Little Piggy"?**

- Went wee wee wee all the way home (turn right)
- Had roast beef (turn left)
- Went to the market (turn left)

**Solve the riddle: I am tall when I'm young, and I'm short when I'm old. What am I?**

- A candle (turn left)
- A tree (turn right)
- A child (turn left)

**Reach up and down the same number of times as there are letters in the alphabet. If you end:**

- Down (turn right)
- Up (turn left)

Hint #1: start up ("a" is up, "b" is down...)

**Who is pictured on the U.S. quarter and/or Canadian \$100 bill?**

- George Washington/Sir Robert Borden (turn left)
- John Adams/Queen Elizabeth II (turn right)
- George Washington/Sir Wilfrid Laurier (turn right)
